

1674508 – 1674514 Amazonite HAKUSUI-MATSU

Amazonite Hakusui-Matsu are very hard natural pigments. They behave more like little gem stones than like the traditional earth colors or organic lake pigments.

The Japanese watercolor market made these types of pigments into a range of different particle sizes.

When the particles prepared in this special way, the particles are larger or smaller particles but all particle sizes very narrow together. These particles work perfectly in thin layers on white paper.

The Japanese used to have protein glues as a binding medium. It is different to use these different sized particle pigments in mixtures, like it is mentioned in traditional European recipes.

- 1674510 Medium, No. 10, approx. 27 μm
- 1674512 Fine, No. 12, approx. 14 μm
- 1674514 Very Fine, No. 14, approx. 5 μm
